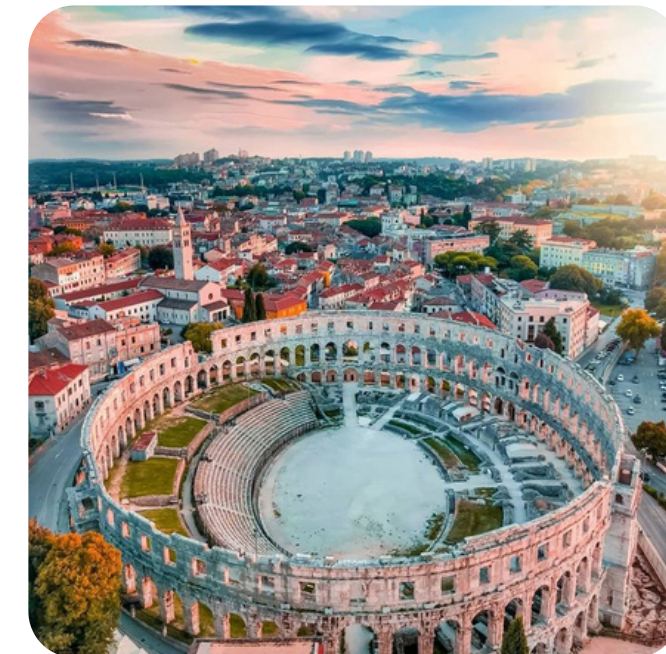
Zagreb

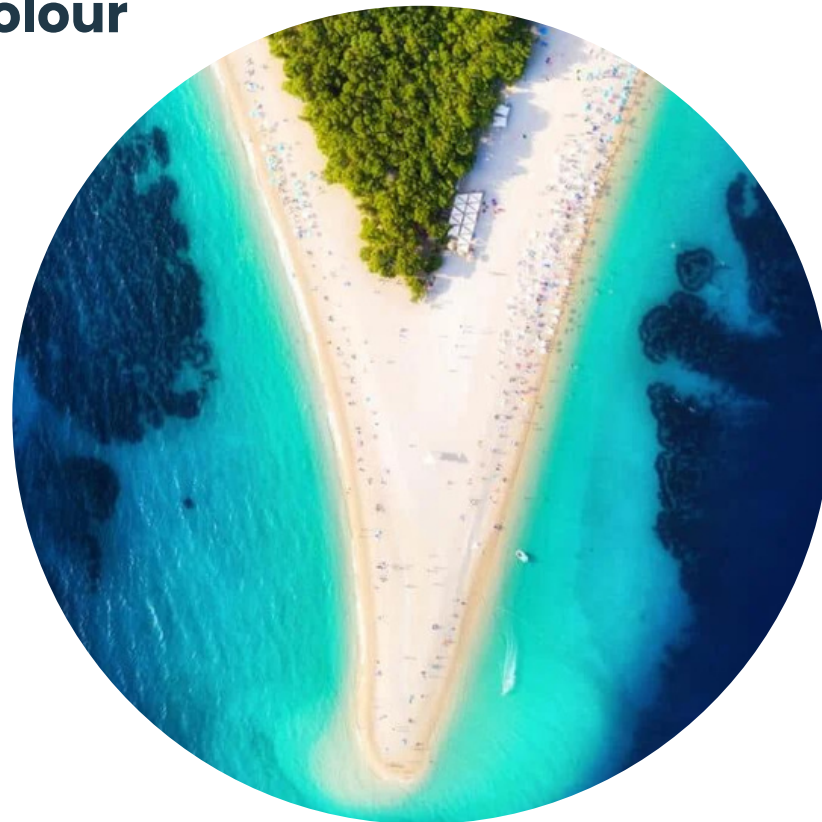
Game of Thrones

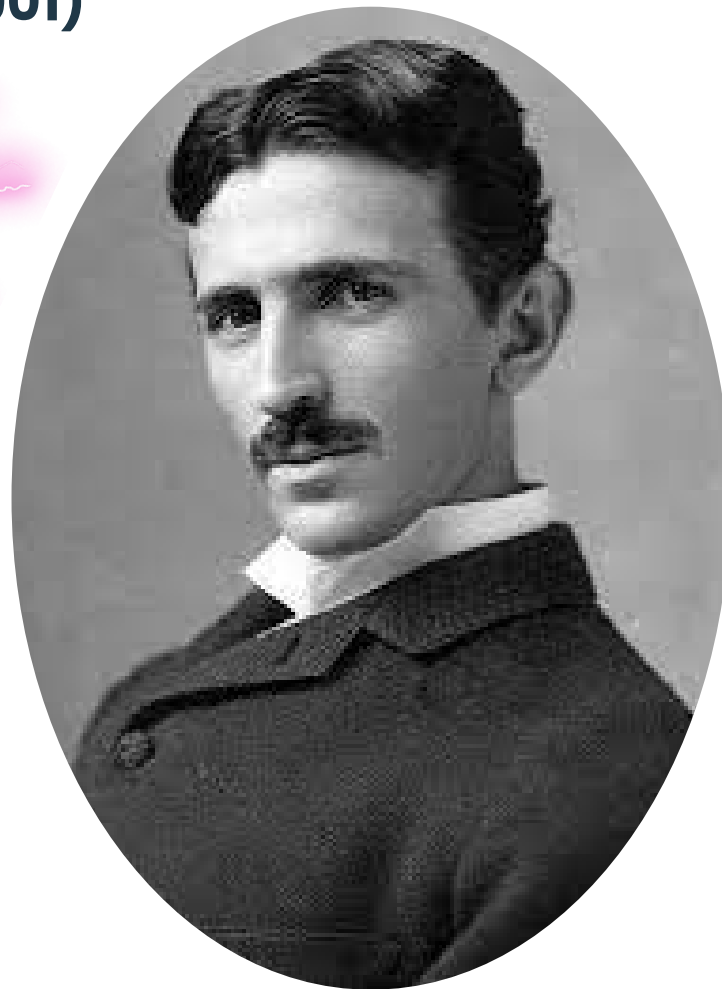

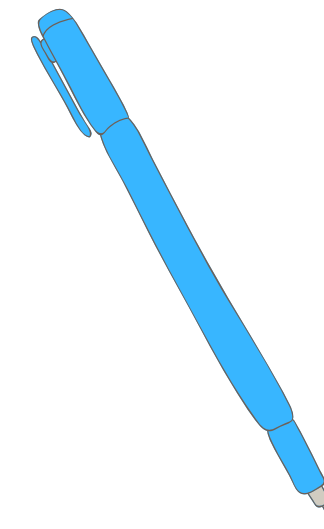
Nikola Tesla

• a tennis player



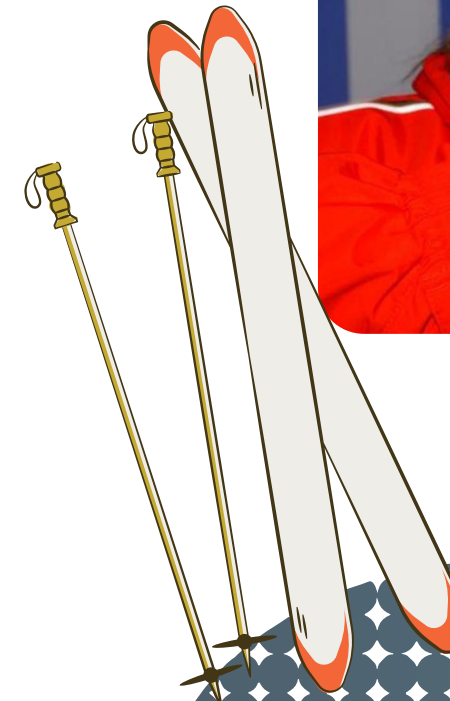
