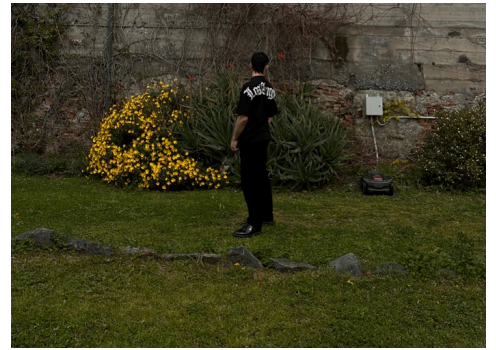

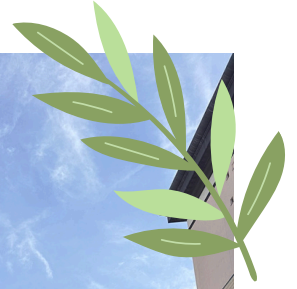
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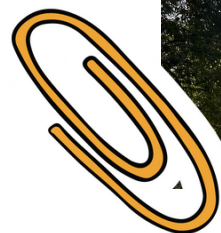


GENOVA

We had the opportunity to learn different languages. So we spent time in Spanish class, tried to introduce ourselves in French and learned Italian through a board game.





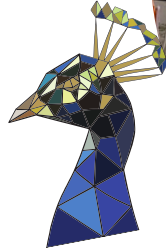
TOUR AROUND SAVONA



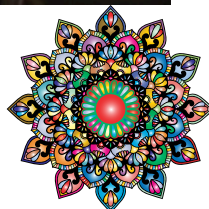
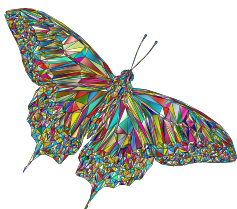
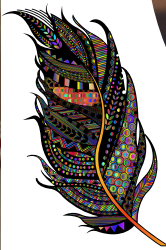

ALTARA AGRIT

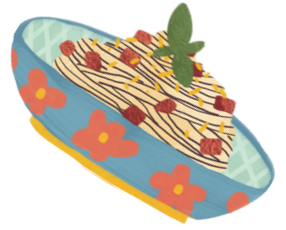


We paid a visit to the Altare agrit glassblowing workshop where we had the opportunity to see the making of handmade, unique blown glass decorations.

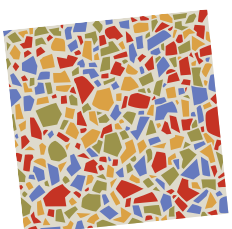
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Visit to **ALBISOLA**



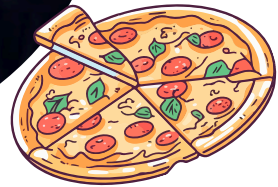
We visited Albisola, a lively seaside resort located along the Riviera di Ponente. We had a walk on its colorful promenade which divides the beach from the main town area.



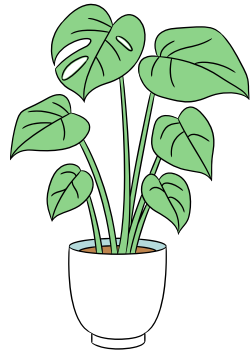

TORINO

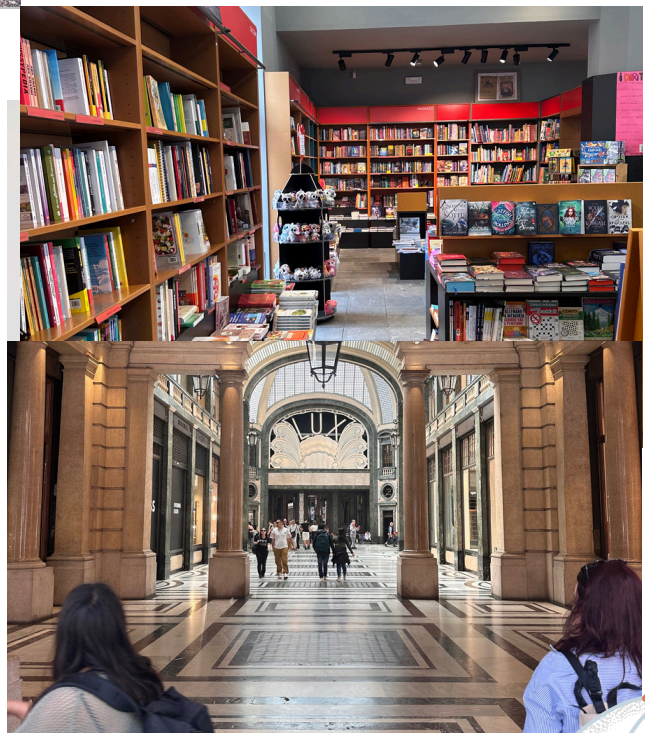


Our last day in italy
